Communicating for Success Train-the-Trainer

Purpose: It is often said, communication is one of our greatest challenges as humans. Establishing a firm foundation of effective communication is vital to a successful, empowered team. Communicating for Success is a train-the-trainer class to equip in-house trainers with the skills and resources to teach the art of communication to all team members in five modules.



OVERVIEW

Communicating for Success is a train-the-trainer session to equip in-house trainers to teach a five module course which can be taught over the course of several weeks or in one 5.5 hour class. The modules explore the foundation for effective communication, skill-building for active listeners, how to speak and make requests, and assertive, but not aggressive, communication as a teambuilding must-have. This class is recommended for long-term care organizations interested in strengthening communication among their team. Highly engaging exercises apply communication skills and attitudes to the workplace environment.



SESSION GOALS

- Identify the primary components of intentional communication.
- Develop a strategy for open and attentive listening to counteract internal listening blocks.
- Combine effective techniques and shifted attitudes of listening for positive peer interactions.
- Compose requests, offer feedback, or persuade someone to take action using the best strategies of presenting an issue.
- Illustrate strategies for assertive communication.
